Master of Business Administration (MBA)

University of the West of Scotland's Master of Business Administration (MBA) course has been radically redesigned for 2014 to reflect the ever-changing nature of businesses, and the global challenges which business leaders are facing. This course focuses on developing strategic analytical skills as well as business intuition and enquiring and adaptive thinking. The new MBA has been structured and designed to allow you, through the selection of option modules, to focus in one of three areas: Finance; Leadership; or Enterprise. This allows you to align your MBA studies to your current career, or career aspiration.



Core Modules

- Integration of Business Functions (10 credits)
- Analytical Thinking and Decision Making (20 credits)
- Managing Organisational Health (20 credits)

Plus one 10 credit module from the options list*

Core Modules

- Influencing Organisational Strategy (20 credits)
- Creativity and Business Wealth (20 credits)

Plus two 10 credit modules from the options list*

Core Modules

- Strategic Business Project (60 credits)

The Strategic Business Project forms your MBA dissertation and will most likely be undertaken within your organisation and/or on a consultancy basis and will require you to bring to bear all of the knowledge and skills that you have developed throughout the MBA on a significant business issue affecting your/an organisation. It may require qualitative and/or quantitative research and analysis. You will be required to develop a suitable proposal which is acceptable to the host organisation, as well as your project supervisor.

Specialization Options

If you plan to focus your MBA studies on Finance, you should choose:

- Advanced Financial Functions (10 credits)
- Global Financial Systems (10 credits)

If you plan to focus your MBA studies on Leadership, you should choose:

- Leading Change (10 credits)
- Influencing Organisational Culture and Change (10 credits)

If you plan to focus your MBA studies on Enterprise, you should choose:

- New Venture Creation (10 credits)
- Business Creativity (10 credits)

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Qualifications and Duration

MBA (full-time/part-time): 1 Year / 2 Years

Entry requirements

Bachelor Degree with CGPA, minimum 2:50 as recognized by the senate PPT OR
Other qualification equivalent to a bachelor's degree with CGPA, minimum 2:50 as recognized by the senate PPT
AND English language proficiency with a minimum of band 6, with a minimum of 5.5 for each component or
score Test of English as a foreign language (TOEFL), a minimum of 80 for Internet Base Test (IBT), with minimum
score 17 for listening, 18 for reading, 20 for speech, 17 for writing, a minimum score of 550 on the Paper Based Test
(PBT) OR a minimum score of 213 for Computer Based Test (CBT)

In exceptional circumstances, applicants may also be considered with other academic, vocational or
professional qualifications deemed to be equivalent. Accreditation of Prior Learning (APL) and Accreditation of
Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) is also applicable subject to UWS approval

How to apply

- Bring along the following for verification and submission
- Copy of all academic qualifications or certificates
- Copy of all academic transcripts, showing full details of subjects studied and grades/marks obtained
- Copy of Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Official English translation of the certificate(s) and transcripts(s) if required
- Two supporting reference letters (one of which must be academic), on headed paper and signed by the referee as supporting documents
- Evidence of your English language ability (e.g. IELTS, TOEFL) if your first language is not English
- 2 copies of passport size photos with blue background
